

Emergency Contraception – How to locate a pharmacy that sells it

Emergency Contraception must be taken within 72 hours (3 days) of having unprotected sexual intercourse or birth control failure.

It's available over the counter for consumers age 17 and older without a prescription, as long as you show a government-issued photo ID. If you're under 17, you'll need to see your healthcare professional or visit your clinic.
