On 02/12/2009, at 4:29 PM, MCTC Public Safety Officers received a report of a male who had exposed himself to two females in the MCTC library. As reported by the victims, on 2/12/2009 at 4:15 PM, the two females were sitting at the individual study areas on the second floor of the library. One of the females noticed a man hiding in between the bookshelves for about 30 minutes. The male then exposed himself to the female victims. One of the females followed him down to the first floor and informed the library staff. The perpetrator ran on foot after being chased by an MCTC student. The perpetrator was not apprehended. One of the female victims stated she has seen this man in the library several times before using the computers.

MCTC Public Safety, upon notification of the incident, searched the campus and immediately notified the Minneapolis Police Department. The suspect was not found. Upon further investigation, MCTC Public Safety has identified a suspect in this case.
