Exam Information:

- Each exam is 2 ½ hours long. Additional time will not be given.
- One hundred (100) multiple choice questions are on each exam.

Emphasis of the exams is on the concepts and tools of macroeconomics and microeconomics. They assess whether or not students understand basic principles and can apply them at the introductory level.

Passing the Exam

A minimum score of 70% is required. No credit is earned.

Not Passing the Exam

- May <u>not</u> register the independent study version of the course;
- Must register for either the classroom or online versions of the course.
