SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS

However, failure to provide the requested information will prevent the processing of your application and the determination of your eligibility for the Cyber Scholarship Program.

- 1. Indicate your name and school name on each supplemental page supplied.
- 2. Letters of reference must contain the referee name, position or title, telephone number, email address and institutional or organizational address and provide the details outlined in the application which include assessment of your knowledge and ability following the six competency areas.
- 3. You must address each requested item for each category or your submission package will be deemed incomplete and will not be considered.

- 5. If you met the initial qualifications, be prepared to be called for a short pre-screening interview at Metropolitan State University Saint Paul Campus done prior to February 27, 2020.
